Question 1: How Much Experience Do You Have with Car Accident Cases?

Not all lawyers are equally equipped to handle car accident claims. You need someone who knows the ins and outs of auto accident law and has a proven track record of results.

- Ask how many car accident cases they've handled.
- Find out their success rate with settlements and trials.
- Check if they specialize in personal injury law.
- Look for client testimonials and past case outcomes.



Question 2: What Is Your Strategy for My Case?

Every accident is unique. A good lawyer should have a clear and customized approach for your case from day one.

- Will they gather evidence like police reports and witness statements?
- How do they plan to deal with the insurance company?
- Will they try to settle or prepare to go to trial?
- Do they involve medical experts or accident reconstructionists?





Question 3: What Are the Legal Fees and Will I Have to Pay Upfront?

Understanding the cost structure is critical. Most personal injury lawyers work on contingency—but always ask.

- Do they charge a percentage of the settlement?
- Are consultations free?
- Will you owe anything if the case is lost?
- Are there any hidden or upfront costs?

Questions 4: How Will You Communicate with Me About My Case?

Good communication builds trust. You want a lawyer who will keep you updated and answer your questions.

- Will you get regular updates by phone or email?
- How quickly do they respond to messages?
- Will you have direct access to your attorney?
- Is there a dedicated team member assigned to your case?





Questions 5: What Is the Value of My Case?

An experienced lawyer should give you a realistic estimate based on facts, not false promises.

- Will they consider medical bills, lost wages, and pain and suffering?
- Are they honest about possible outcomes?
- Do they explain how damages are calculated?
- Will they help you avoid undervaluing your claim?

Questions 6: How Long Will My Case Take to Resolve?

Time is a factor when dealing with injuries and financial stress. Understanding the timeline helps set realistic expectations.



Questions 7: Have You Handled Cases Against My Insurance Company Before?

Insurance companies can be tough. A lawyer with experience dealing with your insurer has an edge.

- Are they familiar with the insurer's tactics?
- Have they won similar cases?
- Can they handle bad-faith insurance practices?
- Do they negotiate strongly or settle quickly?





Questions 8: What Should I Avoid Doing That Could Harm My Case?

One wrong move can weaken your case. Your lawyer should prepare you to avoid common pitfalls.

- Should you avoid speaking to the insurance company directly?
- Are social media posts risky?
- Should you keep a journal of your injuries and recovery?
- Will they help you document everything properly?



You deserve to know who's really working on your case. Make sure you're not just a number at a big firm.

- Will the lead attorney handle your case directly?
- Are paralegals or junior lawyers involved?
- Do you meet your attorney before signing?
- How many cases are they managing at once?

Questions 10: What HappensIf We Don't Win the Case?



Knowing the risks upfront gives you peace of mind. Ask what happens if the outcome isn't in your favor.

- Will you still owe attorney fees?
- Are court costs or filing fees your responsibility?
- Do they have a "No Win, No Fee" guarantee?
- Will they help with appeals or future options?
